TO PLAY

1. Pour Wine 1 into each glass and follow the 4 Tasting steps (See, Swirl, Sniff, Sip).
2. If you're using printed score sheets, fill in your score sheet as you go. Consult the Grape Variety info for help.
3. Personal Rating is your enjoyability rating out of 5 for each wine. The Tasting Notes space is for you to jot down any helpful reminders for each wine.
4. Keep blind tasting the wines in numerical order.
5. You can choose to reveal and score each wine as you play, or all at the end of the game.
6. Enjoy the additional Trivia and Talk prompts between rounds. If you want to be competitive with the Trivia, write answers on the back of score sheets so that points for correct answers can be tallied at the end.
7. Rinse each glass between wines. A pot of ground coffee (just the fresh grounds, without any added water) is a great palate cleanser – take a sniff between each wine.
8. Feel free to serve nibbles e.g. *cheese, cured meat, breadsticks*.
9. Reveal each bottle by removing the paper wrap and use the label for information to award points, one point for each correct answer. For alcohol percentage, award one point for guessing 0.5% either side of the correct answer. For price, award one point for guessing 50p either side of the correct answer.
10. If you added a trivia round, mark these scores separately to the blind tasting score.
11. Ask each player to share their personal rating for each wine, so that participants can discuss their preferences.



Alternative ways to play: Make it a red or white only evening OR make it a country or region only evening e.g. Spanish wines.
