
All workshops are interactive, FREE, take place at the M&S Archive and are 2 hours long.



FASHION AND FABRICS Reception, Key Stages 1-2

Science, History

Pupils use their senses and simple experiments to find out about the properties of fabrics. We also look at how fabric is made and how clothing has changed over time.



WHAT'S ON MY PLATE? Reception, Key Stages 1-2

Science, History

Your class learn about changes in our diet over the last 100 years. Activities encourage thinking about where food comes from and what makes a balanced diet. Pupils design a meal for a child in the past and test their knowledge in our 'What food are you?' game.



BISCUIT BONANZA Reception, Key Stages 1-2

Art & Design, Literacy, Numeracy

Pupils hunt for colour, shape and texture in the Marks in Time exhibition and find out how we use these elements in design. An optional numeracy theme allows pupils to test their maths skills, and finish by designing an M&S biscuit tin that customers will love.



PROOF OF THE PUDDING Reception, Key Stages 1-2

D&T, Science, chocolate topic

Your class explore the challenges and chemistry of the M&S Chocolate Melt in the Middle Pudding through hands-on experiments... and yes, there is a taste test!

D&T, Geography

Pupils design and make their own future-proof packaging inspired by our collection of archive designs and current M&S innovation.

Local History, Drama, Numeracy

Pupils use a variety of sources to find out more about the history of M&S and shopping. Piecing together the clues, they create their own collage of life in the past.
